The KLCPPC is horrified at the mass murder of a Muslim family in London, and regardless if this was a hate-driven or not, we unequivocally condemn this crime.

The third core principle of the PPC is “Respect”. No other party in Canada commits to this core principle. This includes respect for all people. We accept everyone as they are. “We Are All God’s Children”.

Millions across Canada have similarly expressed their outrage. The hate of this one person is not representative of our nation, one of the most open and tolerant countries on earth and which has attracted millions of immigrants to our shores who recognize this truth.

We must do everything we can as a nation to counter hatred in any form and toward any group or religion, Islam or otherwise.

A PPC government would go beyond the platitudes of our current leaders and be far more serious in using already existing law enforcement agencies and laws to identify, track and prosecute to the full extent of the law all hate speech and hate crimes that are already defined in the Criminal Code.

By example and words, we must educate all citizens that hatred is often taught or learned from intolerant family members, ideologies, social groups or a result of media focus on division.

It is not some inevitable result of “the system” and, as leaders and as individuals, we call out the persons who commit hateful speech or acts to engage responsibly and be a role model for our young people.

We will also vigorously oppose using these events as an excuse to impose new sweeping restrictions on free speech such as Bill C-36.
